2025 LENTEN REGULATIONS

1) The days of both Fast and Abstinence during Lent are Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. If possible, the fast on Good Friday is continued until the Easter Vigil (on Holy Saturday night) as the "paschal fast" to honor the suffering and death of the Lord Jesus, and to prepare ourselves to share more fully and to celebrate more readily His Resurrection. The other Fridays of Lent are days of Abstinence.

*On a day of Fast, only one (1) full meal is permitted, and **two (2) smaller meals, which, if added together, would not exceed the main meal in quantity**. Those between the ages of 18 and 59 are obliged to fast. *On a day of Abstinence, no meat may be eaten. Those who have reached the age of 14 are obliged by the law of abstinence.

2) **The obligation to observe the laws of Fast and Abstinence "substantially", or as a whole, is a serious obligation.**

3) The Fridays of the year, outside of Lent, are designated as days of penance, but each individual may substitute for the traditional abstinence from meat some other practice of voluntary self-denial as penance.

4) The time for fulfilling the Paschal Precept (Easter Duty*) extends from the **First Sunday of Lent, March 9, 2025 to the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, May 15, 2025.** **Canon 920, §1.

All the faithful, after they have been initiated into the Most Holy Eucharist, are bound by the obligation of receiving Communion at least once a year.



7º Domingo do Tempo Comum

A liturgia deste domingo desafia-nos a pôr de lado a nossa velha lógica retributiva do “olho por olho, dente por dente”, as nossas contas de mais e de menos para classificarmos os nossos irmãos e as suas ações, e a substituir tudo isso pela lógica do amor. Só assim seremos verdadeiramente filhos do nosso Pai que está no céu.

A **primeira leitura** apresenta-nos David, o homem de coração magnânimo. Tendo a possibilidade de eliminar Saul, o inimigo que o perseguia para o matar, David decidiu não erguer a mão contra o “ungido do Senhor”. David acreditava que a vida pertence a Deus; e só Deus tem o direito de tirar a vida a alguém.

No **Evangelho** Jesus define os traços fundamentais da identidade do verdadeiro discípulo. De acordo com Jesus, o “amor” – o amor gratuito, incondicional, ilimitado, sem fronteiras – está no centro dessa identidade. A grande razão pela qual Jesus convida os discípulos a perdoar, a amar os inimigos, a rezar pelos violentos e os maus, é o facto de serem filhos de um Deus que é amor. Os filhos de Deus são chamados a mostrar ao mundo, com a sua forma de viver e de amar, a bondade, a ternura e a misericórdia de Deus.

Na **segunda leitura** Paulo de Tarso convida-nos a encarmos a morte física como a passagem para uma nova vida, ao lado de Deus, onde continuaremos a ser nós próprios, mas sem os limites que a materialidade do nosso corpo nos impõe. Estamos destinados à comunhão com Deus, a sentarmo-nos todos à mesa do Pai. Se esse é o nosso destino final, fará sentido odiarmos os nossos irmãos enquanto andamos na terra, a caminho da casa do Pai?
