

-We are accepting registrations for the new school year 2023-2024 as of May 14th until July 17th. Registrations received after July 17th will incur a late fee. A copy of the child's Baptism Certificate is required for NEW students and a copy of a Birth Certificate for a Child that has not yet been baptized. Sacramental Preparation classes will also meet once a month (for all those within their two preparatory years of the Sacrament).

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners of St. Cecilia: On many occasions in the parish office, we receive requests from some of our parishioners asking us for a letter that states that they are a parishioners of St. Cecilia Church. These requests include being asked to be a godparent for a baby's baptism; a sponsor for confirmation; a statement to file your taxes stating the annual contribution, and at times, proof of residency in the country, and needing to process documents for Immigration. We are willing to grant these requests; however, it is difficult for us to prove you are a parishioner unless you are registered with the parish. For this reason, we are asking that you register as a parishioner if you are not already registered. Registration cards are available in the parish office. The cards can be dropped in the collection baskets or at the parish office. Online registration is also available. Boletim em Português

14° DOMINGO DO TEMPO COMUM

A liturgia deste domingo ensina-nos onde encontrar Deus. Garante-nos que Deus não Se revela na arrogância, no orgulho, na prepotência, mas sim na simplicidade, na humildade, na pobreza, na pequenez. A primeira leitura apresenta-nos um enviado de Deus que vem ao encontro dos homens na pobreza, na humildade, na simplicidade; e é dessa forma que elimina os instrumentos de guerra e de morte e instaura a paz definitiva. No Evangelho, Jesus louva o Pai porque a proposta de salvação que Deus faz aos homens (e que foi rejeitada pelos "sábios e inteligentes") encontrou acolhimento no coração dos "pequeninos". Os "grandes", instalados no seu orgulho e auto-suficiência, não têm tempo nem disponibilidade para os desafios de Deus; mas os "pequenos", na sua pobreza e simplicidade, estão sempre disponíveis para acolher a novidade libertadora de Deus. Na segunda leitura, Paulo convida os crentes - comprometidos com Jesus desde o dia do Baptismo - a viverem "segundo o Espírito" e não "segundo a carne". A vida "segundo a carne" é a vida daqueles que se instalam no egoísmo, orgulho e auto-suficiência; a vida "segundo o Espírito" é a vida daqueles que aceitam acolher as propostas de Deus.
