



2023 LENTEN REGULATIONS

The Fridays of the year, outside of Lent, are designated as days of penance, but each individual may substitute for the traditional abstinence from meat some other practice of voluntary self-denial as penance. The time for fulfilling the Paschal Precept (Easter Duty*) extends from the First Sunday of Lent, February 26, 2023 to the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, June 4, 2023. **Canon 920, §1. All the faithful, after they have been initiated into the Most Holy Eucharist, are bound by the obligation of receiving Communion at least once a year.

Dear Parishioners of St. Cecilia: On many occasions in the parish office, we receive requests from some of our parishioners asking us for a letter that states that they are a parishioners of St. Cecilia Church. These requests include being asked to be a godparent for a baby's baptism; a sponsor for confirmation; a statement to file your taxes stating the annual contribution, and at times, proof of residency in the country, and needing to process documents for Immigration. We are willing to grant these requests; however, it is difficult for us to prove you are a parishioner unless you are registered with the parish. For this reason, we are asking that you register as a parishioner if you are not already registered. Registration cards are available in the parish office. 

Boletim em Português

05° DOMINGO DA PÁSCOA

A liturgia deste domingo convida-nos a reflectir sobre a Igreja - a comunidade que nasce de Jesus e cujos membros continuam o "caminho" de Jesus, dando testemunho do projecto de Deus no mundo, na entrega a Deus e no amor aos homens. O Evangelho define a Igreja: é a comunidade discípulos que seguem o "caminho" Jesus - "caminho" de obediência ao Pai e de dom da vida aos irmãos. Os que acolhem esta proposta e aceitam viver nesta dinâmica tornam-se Homens Novos, que possuem a vida em plenitude e que integram a família de Deus - a família do Pai, do Filho e do Espírito. A primeira leitura apresenta-nos alguns traços que caracterizam a "família de Deus" (Igreja): é uma comunidade santa, embora formada por homens pecadores; é uma comunidade estruturada hierarquicamente, mas onde o serviço da autoridade é exercido no diálogo com os irmãos; é uma comunidade de servidores, que recebem dons de Deus e que põem esses dons ao serviço dos irmãos; e é uma comunidade animada pelo Espírito, que vive do Espírito e que recebe do Espírito a força de ser testemunha de Jesus na história. A segunda leitura também se refere à Igreja: chama-lhe "templo espiritual", do qual Cristo é a "pedra angular" e os cristãos "pedras vivas". Essa Igreja é formada por um "povo sacerdotal", cuja missão é oferecer a Deus o verdadeiro culto: uma vida vivida na obediência aos planos do Pai e no amor incondicional aos irmãos.
